The UBC graduation journey has been forged by the spirit of the university's motto, *Tuum Est*, (meaning 'it is yours') since 1915. Today, you, the graduating class of 2015, now shape UBC's history by making it your own.



1916

The first graduating class pictured here at the Fairview campus located near Vancouver General Hospital. In UBC's first year, there were only three faculties: Arts, Applied Science and Agriculture with 379 registered students and 34 faculty members.

1920s

The twenties saw the student-led Great Trek to claim UBC's Point Grey campus and establish the university as a place of mind for students the world over. The AMS incorporated as a non-profit society and the university began awarding its first graduate degrees to students. In the *Ubysey*, published in September 23, 1925, students described the new campus with a sense of wonder: "We are dazed with the appearance of architectural cleanliness and bewildered by our lineal freedom."

1940s

The forties were an era of tremendous change at the university as both students and faculty embraced the war effort. In 1943, new President Norman Mackenzie began in earnest to expand the university and new departments were formed along with new buildings to house them including Brock Hall, the first student union building. By the 1950's, UBC had established itself as a comprehensive university and top choice for students in BC and beyond.



2015

Close to 13,000 students will become the Class of 2015. They will go on to join more than 300,000 alumni who have successfully graduated from UBC and continue their journey as treasured members of the UBC community.



1960s

Student numbers continued to escalate alongside the scholarly activities that began to define UBC as a leader in research. The campus was alive with sixties counterculture and a sixth president of UBC was elected by the name of Dr. Walter Gage. New student residences were created to respond to the expanding student body as well as a new student union building. Students gained influence at the university and were elected to the University Board of Governors for the first time.

1980s

With over 34,000 students registered at the beginning of the eighties, UBC began attracting scholars from all over the world. Engineering students were in the news frequently for their pranks, which included the famous Ladner Clock Tower stunt in which students pulled off hoisting a white Volkswagen Bug onto the top of the tower. Dr. Martha Piper was elected President in 1997 and ushered in an era of international engagement that saw UBC step onto the world stage as an educator and global centre for research excellence.

2000s

The demand for increased access to post-secondary education led to the official opening of UBC's Okanagan campus in 2005. Student learning opportunities multiplied as UBC expanded to include two major campuses—the Vancouver Campus and the Okanagan Campus.



The University Mace is a symbol of the authority of the Chancellor. It is displayed on ceremonial occasions, most notably during the convocation ceremonies but also during the Installation of a President or Chancellor.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The Mace is carried by the 'Macebearer' who leads the Platform Party, which includes the Chancellor, the President and other dignitaries, onto the stage for the Convocation ceremonies.

Created by First Nations artist Sheldon Louis of the Okanagan Indian Band, the University Mace is carved from a single piece of alder wood, and combines Okanagan Nation traditions with university customs. The main art work on the Mace features three symbolic spirit icons—a mother bear with her two cubs, the image of the mountains, and water—given to UBC Okanagan in 2005 by the Okanagan Nation elders. The spirit icon gifts were selected by a group of First Nation elders, led by Andrew McGinnis, an Okanagan Traditional Medicine Keeper from the Penticton Indian Band, and Victor Antoine, an elder of the Okanagan Indian Band. Each spirit icon was chosen carefully for its special significance to the region, reflecting local Okanagan Nation tradition, culture and knowledge.

The Mace also features a number of university symbols, including the UBC Okanagan logo, the University coat of arms and the UBC motto *Tuum Est* – It's Yours. In addition, the back of the Mace displays the word *Suknaqinx*, which is of the Nsyilxcen language, spoken by the Okanagan's original people. Roughly translated, it means "the ones who stand on the hill and are seen and heard from far away."

The University Mace, which was carved in the shape of a paddle, representing the importance of Okanagan Lake to the region's people, is also inlaid with silver, applied by First Nations silversmith artist Justin Terbasket of the Lower Similkameen Indian Band. The Mace was used for the first time at the 2009 Convocation Ceremonies.

THE PROCESSION

Chancellor Lindsay Gordon shakes the hand of every student that crosses the stage—that's over 10,000 students each year. This handshake signifies the transition between student and graduate.

REGALIA COLOURS

The hoods, gowns and hats worn by graduates are lined with colours to indicate the degree to be conferred, a tradition dating back to the Middle Ages when the first universities were founded.

THE CHANCELLOR'S OKANAGAN CHAIR

In 2007, UBC's Okanagan campus commissioned the creation of a new Chancellor's chair for use in Okanagan Convocation ceremonies. Handcrafted by master furniture maker Dennis Weidman of Lake Country, BC, the chair was fashioned from cherry wood, a species selected for its significance in the Okanagan's long history as a fruit-growing region.

The chair's front panel features UBC's motto, *Tuum Est*, the UBC logo laser engraved in the headrest panel, and UBC's coat of arms on each side panel.

Not only have you successfully completed degree requirements at one of the world's finest universities, you have the added distinction of being alumni of a 100-year-old institution.

On behalf of the 300,000 alumni of the University of British Columbia, I am honoured to extend my sincere congratulations to all graduating students, and to welcome all of those who have supported you on what I hope has been an enjoyable and transformational journey.

It may be an obvious statement, but it merits repeating—today is a day for great celebration. Not only have you successfully completed degree requirements at one of the world's finest universities, you have the added distinction of being alumni of a 100-year-old institution.

For most students, there have been some trying times along the way; term paper and assignment deadlines, adjusting to new living arrangements in a new city or an entirely new part of the world, financial strains, and maybe even some anxiety over what happens next. But you made it, and that alone speaks compellingly about your character; that you are disciplined, resourceful and able to begin and complete a challenging task. As a UBC graduate, you are now different in the eyes of a great many of those whom you will meet.

As to what happens next, the way forward for some of you is clear, while for others the future remains uncertain. Compelling evidence of widening skills needs can be found among your fellow graduates who live and work in some 150 countries. Every department or program at UBC has produced graduates who are today net contributors to an infinite range of endeavours. Remember too that if you could see into your future, you might well be astonished by the unexpected, and hopefully intriguing, roads you will take on the next phase of your journey. In the meantime, rest assured that, through your accomplishments at UBC, you have already made a powerful statement about your character.

With that in mind, I encourage you to reflect on what you overcame to arrive at this momentous juncture, and celebrate with great enthusiasm your new distinction as a graduate of the University of British Columbia.

One final thought. Graduation should never mean goodbye—learning is a lifelong journey. I sincerely hope that you will remain active alumni of UBC and that many of you will join us for your university's 100th anniversary celebrations this September, which will include the grand opening of the new Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre.

PRESIDENT'S WELCOME



Warmest congratulations! Graduation is a momentous day in your life. It is a time to look back at all you've accomplished and a time to look ahead to what's next.

This fall marks the 100th anniversary of UBC's first class. It's difficult to imagine switching places with a member of that first class in 1915. They certainly weren't updating Facebook and Instagram or thinking about how they would get ahead in the fiercely competitive global job market.

The Okanagan Song is based on a traditional song style called *skəlmxqin*. *Skəlmxqin* songs belong to the Okanagan/Syilx people collectively. Songs of this style can be sung by any Okanagan/Syilx person using their own phrasing and their own emotion while maintaining the formal rhythm and structure. This song has been called the "Okanagan Song" or the "Okanagan Nation Anthem" because the phrasing and meaning were constructed to celebrate pride in being Okanagan.

Translation of *suknaqinx skəlmxqinx*

Note: the word *aʔi* translates three separate ways in this song.

Aʔi kʷu swi wi numtax

(given that we are good-looking/vibrant/
strong)

Aʔi kʷu suknaqinx

(due to being Okanagan)

Aʔi axaʔ iʔ tmxʷulaʔxʷ

(because of this land)

We are beautiful
Because we are Okanagan
Because our land is beautiful

SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS & CONTRIBUTIONS

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

PHILIP JOHN CURRIE

Doctor of Science, honoris causa

Philip John Currie has served as a seminal force in developing Canada's reputation for excellence in palaeontology and is an inspiring mentor for up-and-coming Canadian scientists.

His accomplishments have led to a greater understanding of dinosaurs, particularly theropods such as Tyrannosaurids and their scientific significance, and did much to establish the link between birds and dinosaurs. Dr. Currie helped found the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology in Drumheller, Alberta. He also served as Co-director of the Canada-China Dinosaur Project in 1986 and was Curator of Earth Sciences at the Provincial Museum of Alberta.

Dr. Currie received his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Toronto, a Master of Science from McGill University, followed by a Ph.D. in Biology (with distinction) in 1981. He is currently

Professor and Canada Research Chair in Dinosaur Paleobiology at the University of Alberta.

Over the past 25 years he has worked on fossil recovery projects in Mongolia, Argentina, Australia, Dinosaur Provincial Park, and many other locations. Together with colleagues he has named 25 new dinosaurs and other fossil reptiles, and three have been named in his honour.

Dr. Currie has received many honours and awards, including the Outstanding Leadership in Alberta Science Award, the Canadian Museums Association Award for Distinguished Service, and the Michael Smith Award for Science Promotion from the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada. He is a Fellow of both the Royal Canadian Geographic Society and the Royal Society of Canada.

In 2010, he was awarded the Alberta Order of Excellence, and in 2012, the Royal Canadian Geographical Society's Gold Medal.



SARA SEAGER

Doctor of Science, honoris causa

Sara Seager is a Canadian-American astronomer and planetary scientist whose research focuses on theory, computation, and data analysis of planets orbiting stars far from our own solar system.

She has introduced many new ideas to the field of exoplanet characterization, including work that led to the first detection of an exoplanet atmosphere.

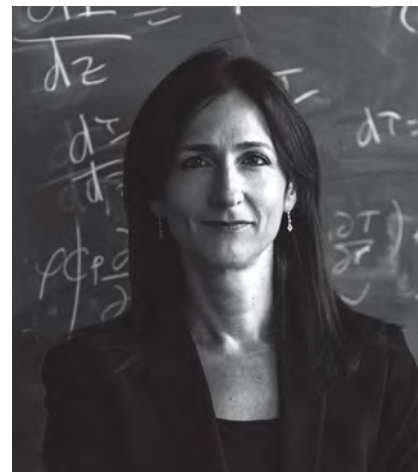
Dr. Seager was also part of a team that co-discovered the first detection of light emitted from an exoplanet and she introduced many of the concepts on which the field of exoplanet atmospheres is now based. She is the author of two textbooks on these topics.

Born in Toronto, she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in mathematics and physics from the University of Toronto

and a Ph.D. in astronomy from Harvard University in 1999. She held a post-doctoral research fellow position at the Institute for Advanced Study in Princeton, New Jersey, and was a senior research staff member at the Carnegie Institution of Washington through 2006. She joined the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 2007 where she is now Professor of Physics and the Class of 1941 Professor of Planetary Science.

In 2013, Dr. Seager was awarded a prestigious MacArthur Fellowship, sometimes referred to as a "genius grant," for her work on detecting chemical signatures in exoplanet atmospheres and developing low-cost space observatories to observe planetary transits.

Other awards and honours include election to the US National Academy of Sciences in 2015, the Raymond and Beverly Sackler Prize in the Physical



Sciences, the American Astronomical Society's Helen B. Warner Prize, and a lifetime honorary membership in the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada.

AWARD FOR TEACHING EXCELLENCE AND INNOVATION

SENIOR FACULTY AWARD

Dr. Stephen Porter

Associate Professor, Irving K. Barber School of Arts and Sciences

Dr. Porter is a distinguished researcher who excels at teaching and mentoring both undergraduate and graduate students.

A co-founder of the CFI-funded Centre for the Advancement of Psychological Sciences and Law, since coming to UBC Okanagan in 2008, Dr. Porter has supervised 10 graduate students, more than 30 honours theses, and countless directed studies projects.

Dr. Porter founded the extremely popular undergraduate forensic specialization program, which enables undergraduate students completing their honours degrees to engage in forensic psychology-related research while also gaining hands-on experience in forensic settings—such as working with the John Howard Society, restorative justice, or with the parole system.

He is consistently ranked highly by his students, earning recognition for teaching excellence in four of his six years since arriving at UBC. Students often comment that he brings courses to life, using real-world examples from his own consulting experience and his work as a prison psychologist to better explain topics.

He worked closely with his colleagues on the development of the new clinical psychology graduate program, helping to plan courses and clinical practica.

In his lectures, exercises such as role plays help students understand course material in a more applied manner. Dr. Porter's comprehensive knowledge of the field allows students to complete courses with a deep understanding of the subject and the ability to apply their acquired knowledge in their careers.

He is a dynamic teacher who seamlessly connects teaching and research at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and encourages and motivates his students to challenge themselves and excel in their learning.

JUNIOR FACULTY AWARD

Dr. Ray Taheri

Senior Instructor, Faculty of Applied Sciences' School of Engineering

Dr. Taheri's colleagues praise him as "a shining light for the School of Engineering" and "an exemplary individual... when you meet him, you do not forget him."

Dr. Taheri is an excellent teacher and a true innovator who consistently delivers undergraduate courses of very high quality.

He designed the new Applied Science 171 course, adding 3-D printing to a Computer Aided Design course that was already anything but traditional. He is a champion of project-based learning, and genuinely enjoys teaching engineering design courses—though they are difficult to teach and grade because of the open-ended nature of the process.

He and colleague Wilson Eberle have built the fourth-year Engineering Capstone course from being little-known in 2008 to become one of the most successful capstone programs in Canada.

Dr. Taheri's humanitarian work is also part of his teaching. In the first-year design course, Engineering students design innovative devices to crush cans. Dr. Taheri took the crushed cans in for their refund value and donated the funds to a school in Moldova. This philanthropy is included in the course materials, and serves an example of his passion for teaching and helping foster global awareness in his students.

Dr. Taheri approaches teaching as a way of life. His contributions have elevated the profile of teaching and indeed the School of Engineering's reputation across UBC.
